CORRIGENDUM NO. 5 TO LETTER INVITING TENDER

Job ref.: Contract for Operation & Management of NRL Football Academy.

Further to the tender for the above job, bidders are requested to note the following.

There has been further relaxation in the **Pre-Qualifying Criteria (PQC_ point No. A of tender Document)** and **Bid Evaluation Methodology (Point No. F of 'Scope of Work' of Tender Document)** as mentioned below:

1. Pre-Qualifying Criteria (Point No. A):

- (A) Past Experience of having successfully completed similar works* during last 10 years ending last day of month previous to the one in which the original bid due date falls, should be either of the following:

One similar work costing not less than Rs.322.49 Lakhs, or
Two similar works costing not less than Rs.257.99 Lakhs each, or
Three similar works costing not less than Rs.193.49 Lakhs each.

*Similar Works:

Experience in Operating & Maintaining AIFF-Accredited Football Academy in India:

- i. The bidder must have experience of operating and maintaining at least one (01) football academy / Club duly accredited by the All India Football Federation (AIFF) with a minimum 2-Star Academy Accreditation rating or above in India, for at least two (02) years in the last 10 years ending last day of month previous to the one in which the original bid due date falls.

- ii. The academy/ club must have participated in I-League Youth / Junior competitions in at least two (02) age categories during the period of operation.

The bidder shall submit any one of the following documents in support of this:

- a. Copies of Work Orders / Agreements along with completion or continuation certificates. In the case of clubs, if formal work orders or agreements are not applicable, an undertaking in the form of a certification by the Club President/Secretary stating that the football academy is operational needs to be provided.
b. Submission of Certificate from client(s) for bidders apart from Clubs/ Self- Certification in case of Clubs certifying the details of coaching programs / academies and strength of cadets / trainees /record of participation in I –League.
c. Certificate(s) issued by AIFF confirming academy accreditation and star rating."

2. Point No. F (Bid Evaluation Methodology of Scope of Work of Tender Document)

F. BID Evaluation Methodology:

The bids will be evaluated in 02 stages:

- I. Pre-Qualification Criteria (PQC) Evaluation.
- II. Quality cum Cost Based System (QCBS) evaluation.

1. Evaluation as per PQC: Bidders shall first be evaluated against the Pre-Qualification Criteria (PQC) specified in the tender document. Bidder(s) who meet all of the PQC shall be qualified for QCBS evaluation. Evaluation shall be strictly based on verifiable documentary evidence submitted along with the Technical Bid. Non-submission of required documentary proof shall render the bid liable for rejection.

2. Quality cum Cost Based System (QCBS) evaluation: QCBS evaluation process shall have 02 stages – Quality based evaluation and Cost based evaluation. Quality based evaluation for attaining Technical Score shall have a maximum score of 100 and the Cost based evaluation for attaining Financial Score shall have a maximum score of 100. Final ranking on H1 basis shall be based on the Combined Weighted Score (Final Score) wherein 70% weightage is for Technical Score and 30% weightage is for Financial Score. Formula for the same is mentioned elsewhere in this document.

Quality based evaluation: The break-up of Technical Score of 100 is tabulated below:

The bidders who have minimum Technical Score of 65 out of 100 in the above Quality Based Evaluation shall be qualified for opening of the price bid for Cost Based Evaluation for obtaining Financial Score.

ii) Cost Based Evaluation:

Under Cost Based Evaluation, the following formula shall be used –

C = Price Quote as provided by the bidder

C Low = Lowest Price Quote among the bidders

Then, Financial Score = $C \text{ Low}/C \times 100$

iii) QCBS Evaluation: Combined score of Quality and Cost based evaluation will be done as per following formula:

$$S = (T/T \text{ High} \times 0.70) \times 100 + (C \text{ Low}/C \times 0.30) \times 100 \text{ (Ref table below)}$$

S = Final Score of bidder

T = Technical score of the bidder

T High = Highest Technical score among bidders

C = Price Quote as provided by the bidder

C Low = Lowest Price Quote among the bidders

The successful bidder will be the one who has highest Final Score (S). In the event two or more proposals have the same scores in the final ranking, the proposal with the higher Technical Score shall be ranked first. In case of further tie, lottery will be conducted by the constituted committee of NRL in the presence of the tied bidders.

Notes:

- ABC is highest combined scorer, i.e H-1 bidder and would be selected for further negotiation and contract signing.
- MNY could not qualify in Technical evaluation cut off marks of 65 and therefore not considered for Cost Based Evaluation.
