Obligations of /Assistance from the Government

To enable NRL to achieve the agreed targets in the year 2012-13, assistance from MOP&NG / Government are sought on following matters:

- i) Government will make best efforts to make available Crude Oil and Natural Gas to NRL in similar manner as in 2011-12 for the next year 2012-13 too. Supply of 2710 TMT crude oil and 160 TMT Natural Gas during 2012-13 is essential for NRL to achieve the MOU targets.
- ii) Continuance of Excise Duty benefit at the existing level of 50%.

Obligations of /Assistance from BPCL/OIL

To enable NRL to achieve the agreed targets in the year 2012-13, assistance from BPCL and OIL are sought on following matters:

- i) Timely evacuation of products from Numaligarh Refinery.
- ii) Smooth transportation of products through the Numaligarh Siliguri Product Pipeline operated by M/s Oil India Ltd.
